Andrew believes the finest wines are shaped first in the vineyard. Through meticulous vineyard management, minimal intervention and a steadfast commitment to quality, he guides each vintage to reflect the purity of the fruit and the unique character of Tasmania's north-west coast.

His approach is grounded in patience, precision and respect for the land—resulting in elegant, balanced wines that are both authentic and unmistakably reflective of Scott's Mill Estate.

THE BRIGGS FAMILY

The Briggs family's connection to food, land and exceptional Tasmanian produce began with the establishment of Verona Italian Restaurant & Bar in 2017.

In 2020, the purchase of the historic Turners Beach property marked the beginning of Scott's Mill Estate—a family-owned vineyard shaped by the cool maritime climate, fertile coastal soils and enduring heritage of Tasmania's north-west coast.

Today, the Briggs family is devoted to crafting limited-production wines that express the purity of the fruit, the character of the vineyard and the distinctive beauty of their coastal home.

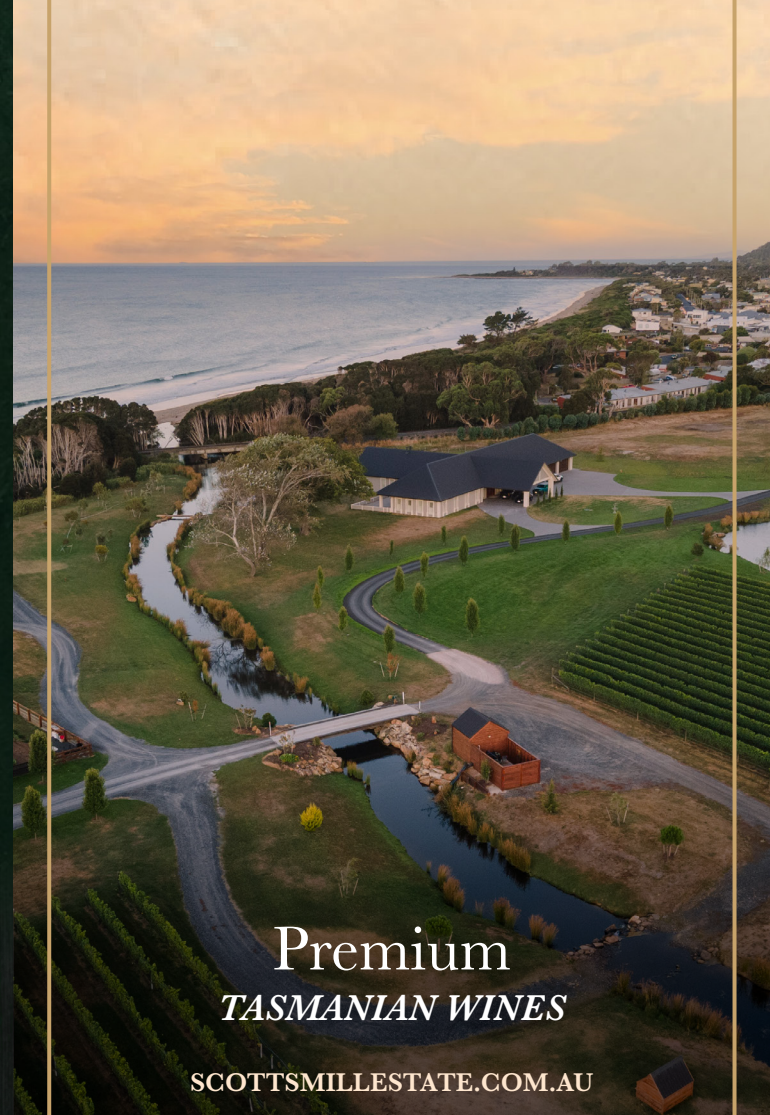
SHAPED BY PLACE. CRAFTED WITH INTENTION.

Our philosophy is one of considered restraint. We holistically farm the vineyard, hand-harvest every grape and work in harmony with the seasons to nurture living soils, biodiversity and exceptional fruit quality.

In the winery, intervention is kept to a minimum, using only the sulphites necessary to preserve freshness, balance and integrity. By avoiding unnecessary additions, we allow the purity of the fruit and the character of the vineyard to shine through, creating wines that feel clean, vibrant and beautifully refined, to wake the next morning with no residual reminder.

Scott's Mill Estate is a family-owned boutique vineyard and winery located at Turners Beach on Tasmania's spectacular north-west coast.

Rich in history, the estate was once home to a water-powered flour mill built in 1828—a place of craftsmanship, hard work and community.

Positioned just metres from the Bass Strait, our vineyard benefits from cooling ocean breezes, a maritime climate and fertile coastal soils. These natural conditions encourage slow, even ripening and produce wines of elegance, vibrancy and a true sense of place.

Every bottle reflects our land, our family's dedication and our commitment to crafting premium cool-climate wines that capture the beauty and character of Tasmania.



OUR PHILOSOPHY

Everything begins in the vineyard.

By nurturing living soils, embracing our coastal climate and hand-harvesting every grape, we allow each vintage to reveal its own character.

In the winery, gentle handling and minimal intervention preserve the purity of the fruit. We use only the sulphites necessary—supporting a more mindful approach to freshness, integrity and wellbeing.
